The Mesabi Trail offers an abundance of natural and outdoor experiences. Bike, hike, skate, ski, snowshoe, and, in some areas, snowmobile along the Trail as it traverses more than 150 miles of completed trail (165 when finished).

Explore historic buildings, mining artifacts, early industry and ethnic history, plus other treasures well worth the discovery. Forests teeming with wildlife can be found between rolling hills. Streams and creeks provide habitat for birds and animals. Grand heaps of earth provide manmade mountains that are becoming re-growth forests lining the edges of some of the world's largest mines. These former mines are fast becoming a linked chain of watery passageways. Come enjoy a quality guest experience in the Land of Mesabi, via the Mesabi Trail.

Mesabi Trail® Wheel Pass Vendors

A wheel pass is required for ages 18 and over using a wheeled device such as a bicycle or inline skates. Hikers, joggers, walkers and people with disabilities are not required to purchase a pass. Cost is \$20 for an annual and \$10 for a three-day pass. Revenue from Wheel Pass sales helps support the Mesabi Trail. Passes are available at mesabitrail.com, at any of these vendors, or at self-pay boxes along the Trail.



On your way out, pedal or stroll through the historic Olcott Park, grab a bite to eat at the communityowned co-op, or satisfy your sweet tooth at Minnesota's oldest candy store. Then, cycle across Minnesota's tallest bridge and climb up and through Pike Rock Cut to Gilbert.





LAURENTIAN

Laurentian — "Ride the Laurentian Divide" Giants Ridge through the Embarrass Lowland and all the way to Tower. See what 'up north' looks like as you cycle the Laurentian segment where cyclists have been known to spot a moose or two!



Gilbert to Tower **50.4 MILES**



Discover the Minnesota iron north on the Vermilion segment. Cycle or hike among Vermilion boreal forests, where tall pines stretch endlessly to the sky. Fly like an eagle through stunning bedrock cuts that showcase the area's unique geology, and maybe even catch a glimpse of common Vermilion wildlife: moose, deer, mink, raccoon, porcupines, and bear.

Rules for Conduct

- Wheel Pass required for ages 18 years and older using a bicycle, inline skates or other non-motorized wheeled device.
- The Mesabi Trail is a non-motorized trail, except snowmobiles where designated.
- Electric assist (E-Bikes) are allowed.
- Non-motorized vehicles and motorized wheel chairs shall not exceed 36" in width.
- Keep pets on a leash no longer than 6' long
- · Holes or trenches may not be dug.
- · No signs or advertisements.
- Start fires only in officially designated fire rings, stove or grills. Do not leave a fire unattended. Be sure fire is extinguished before leaving the area.
- · No hunting, loaded weapons or alcohol.
- Do not remove, alter, injure or destroy any tree, plant, rock, soil or mineral.
- Camping and horseback riding are allowed only in designated areas.
- EMERGENCY CALL 911.
- Report all infractions to 911.
- Audible signal when passing: "on your left"

Snowmobiles allowed within the corridor of these areas only: Grand Rapids to Hwy 61; Coleraine to connection of Taconite Trail, and; Hibbing to Buhl.
