The Mesabi Trail offers an abundance of natural and outdoor experiences. Bike, hike, skate, ski, snowshoe, and, in some areas, snowmobile along the Trail as it traverses more than 165 miles of completed trail.

Explore historic buildings, mining artifacts, early industry and ethnic history, plus other treasures well worth the discovery. Forests teeming with wildlife can be found between rolling hills. Streams and creeks provide habitat for birds and animals. Grand heaps of earth provide man-made mountains that are becoming re-growth forests lining the edges of some of the world's largest mines. These former mines are fast becoming a linked chain of watery passageways. Come enjoy a quality guest experience in the Land of Mesabi, via the Mesabi Trail.

### Rules for Conduct

- Wheel Pass required for ages 18 years and older using a bicycle, inline skates or other non-motorized wheeled device.
- The Mesabi Trail is a non-motorized trail, except snowmobiles where designated\*.
- Electric assist (E-Bikes) are allowed.
- Non-motorized vehicles and motorized wheel chairs shall not exceed 36" in width.
- Keep pets on a leash no longer than 6' long
- Holes or trenches may not be dug.
- No signs or advertisements.
- Start fires only in officially designated fire rings, stove or grills. Do not leave a fire unattended. Be sure fire is extinguished before leaving the area.
- No hunting, loaded weapons or alcohol.
- Do not remove, alter, injure or destroy any tree, plant, rock, soil or mineral.
- Camping and horseback riding are allowed only in designated areas.
- EMERGENCY CALL 911.
- Report all infractions to 911.
- Audible signal when passing: "on your left"
- Stay to the right on corners
- Yield to pedestrians
- Manage speed going downhill, especially around corners
- Stay to right on downhill descents

\*Snowmobiles allowed within the corridor of these areas only: Hwy 61 to Coleraine, Nashwauk to Keewatin and Hibbing to Buhl.

**ELECTRIC BIKES NOTICE**  
Electric-assist or pedal-assist bicycles are allowed on state trails, or wherever normal bicycles are allowed, if they meet the following definition in Minnesota Statutes 169.011, Subdivision 27.

### Mesabi Trail® Wheel Pass Vendors

A wheel pass is required for ages 18 and over using a wheeled device such as a bicycle or inline skates. Hikers, joggers, walkers and people with disabilities are not required to purchase a pass. Cost is \$20 for an annual and \$10 for a three-day pass. Revenue from Wheel Pass sales helps support the Mesabi Trail. Passes are available at mesabitrail.com, at any of these vendors, or at self-pay boxes along the Trail.

## VERMILION

Discover the Minnesota iron north on the Vermilion segment. Cycle or hike among Vermilion boreal forests, where tall pines stretch endlessly to the sky. Fly like an eagle through stunning bedrock cuts that showcase the area's unique geology, and maybe even catch a glimpse of common Vermilion wildlife: moose, deer, mink, raccoon, porcupines, and bear.

#### Service Areas and Pricing

Shuttle services available from Grand Rapids to Ely and all points in between. Up to 4 bikes and passengers per trip. (larger groups, please call for availability). Rates determined by distance and drive time based from Mesabi Trail Station in Eveleth. There is a fee for mileage to and from. There may also be a charge on recumbents, tandems or e-bikes.

The shuttle is not an on-call service, except in an emergency. Please reserve your shuttle at least 24 hours in advance or more. A cell number is required.

**A \$50 deposit will be charged at the time of reservation that is nonrefundable. Payment may be made by credit card, check or cash.**

# Mesabi Trail Access Points

- 1 GRAND RAPIDS** 1336 Fairgrounds Road Grand Rapids, MN 55744 Park at north end of Itasca Co. Fairgrounds Campground parking lot.
- 2 COLERAINE** 803 Cole Street, Coleraine, MN 55722 Park at Longyear Park (400 Cole St)
- 3 BOVEY** 1st Street & 1st Ave, Bovey, MN 55709 Park on any of the city streets
- 4 TACONITE** Bennett Street & Hodgins Ave, Taconite, MN 55786 Parking available at the Community Center
- 5 MARBLE** Near - 603 Alice Ave Marble, MN 55764 Park behind the ball field
- 6 CALUMET** Gary Street & Hill-Annex Minnesota State Park Road, Calumet, MN 55716 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 7 PENGILLY** Minnesota Highway 65, Pengilly When you turn from Hwy 169 onto Hwy 65, parking is immediately to your left
- 8 NASHWAUK** Near - 703 1st St Nashwauk, MN 55769 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 9 KEEWATIN** West 3rd Avenue & North 7th Street Keewatin, MN 55753 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 10 HIBBING** 1201 Greyhound Boulevard Hibbing, MN 55746 Parking available at the Greyhound Bus Museum parking lot
- 11 CHISHOLM** East Lake Street & 1st Ave SE Chisholm, MN 55719 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 12 BUHL** Culver Ave & State Street Buhl, MN 55713 Park on any city street near the Mesabi Trail entry point kiosk

- 13 KINNEY** Hwy 169 & Co Hwy 25 Great Scott Township, MN From Hwy 169, exit north onto Co Hwy 25 and continue 3/10 mile towards Kinney, but not into town. Trail access and parking lot are on the left.
- 14 MOUNTAIN IRON** Locomotive Street & Mesabi Ave Mountain Iron, MN 55768 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 15 VIRGINIA** 1428 North 9th Ave Virginia, MN 55792 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 16 GILBERT** Kansas Ave & Ore-Be-Gone Drive Gilbert, MN 55741 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point
- 17 EVELETH** **MESABI STATION** 111 Station 44 Road Eveleth, MN 55734 This access point is at Mesabi Station, Trailhead for the Mesabi Trail. Parking available at lower level parking lot near the entry point kiosk. *NOTE - this is a spur from the main trail.*  
**FAYAL POND** 1502 Minnesota 37 Eveleth, MN 55734 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point. Access to the Trail is to the east, under the Hwy 53 over-pass, immediately after the exit ramp. *NOTE - this is a spur from the main trail.*  
**FAYAL TOWNSHIP** 4375 Shady Lane Eveleth, MN 55734 Parking available at the Township Hall
- 18 MCKINLEY** 5252 Heritage Trail Gilbert, MN 55741 Parking available near Mesabi Trail entry point

- 19 BIWABIK** **BIWABIK** 6233 Minnesota 135 Biwabik, MN 55708 Parking near Mesabi Trail entry point  
**EMBARRASS LAKE** 5966 Minnesota 135 Biwabik, MN 55705 Direct access to the Mesabi Trail and parking right off Hwy 135 at the Wayside Rest & Boat Landing.  
**GIANTS RIDGE** 6329 Wynne Creek Drive Biwabik, MN 55708 This access point is right at the entrance to Giants Ridge ski resort. Parking at the resort.
- 20 AURORA** Hill Street & Co Hwy 100 Aurora, MN 55705 Parking at the Mesabi Trail entry point kiosk and yellow archway. *NOTE - this is a spur from the main trail, there is no connectivity east beyond Aurora.*
- 21 EMBARRASS** 4846 Highway 21 Embarrass, MN 55732 Parking very near the Mesabi Trail entry point kiosk. *NOTE - the Trail travels north for 9.5 miles and dead ends at Hwy 26, about 6 miles short of Tower. There is no connectivity to Tower at this time. It is NOT recommended to detour to the shoulder of Hwy 135 as there is no shoulder. Pavement will be completed in 2026*
- 22 TOWER** Pine Street & Poirier Road Tower, MN 55790 Park in the lot by the Civic Center and Trail Museum. Access the Mesabi Trail just a half block south.
- 23 SOUDAN** Breitung Monument Park 5263 Hwy 169 Soudan, Mn 55782 There is parking and a paved path that connects to the greater Mesabi Trail

- 24 EAGLES NEST** 1552 Bear Head State Park Road Ely, MN 55731 Eagles Nest is 13 miles southwest of Ely off Hwy 169, on the way to Bear Head State Park. Parking is near the Township Hall at the Mesabi Trail entry point kiosk.
- 25 ELY** **ELY** Pioneer Road & Miners Drive East Ely, MN 55731 Park in the lot off Miners Drive east, look for the Mesabi Trail entry point kiosk. Access to the Trail is to the east across Pioneer Rd. You can also access the Trezona City Trail here.  
Hwy 169 and Co Hwy 88, Ely, MN 55731 Additional access point at the intersection of Hwy 169 and Co Hwy 88 in Ely
